

## **Part-Time Firefighter / EMT**

### **Application Due Date: Continuously Open**

Camano Island Fire & Rescue is currently accepting applications for Part-Time Fire Fighter / EMT position(s). Part-Time Fire Fighter / EMT's work a rotating 12 hour or a 24 hour shift. Camano Island Fire & Rescue will utilize an oral board interview, application review process, medical / physical exam, and CPAT physical ability test for eligibility. ### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Minimum age of 18 years
- High School graduate or GED equivalency
- Washington State certified Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)
- Valid Washington State driver's license
- Must be able to speak, read and write the English language
- In good physical and mental health with a current UA screening
- Must sign a waiver authorizing Camano Island Fire & Rescue to conduct background investigation including: a criminal history check, drivers check, and employment history verification.
- Must be certified as a IFSAC Fire Fighter 1
- Valid and current CPAT Certificate
- Certificate of completion for the on-line FEMA ICS-100 and ICS-200 course materials will be required for continued part-time participation.

Application packets are available on-line or by calling the Fire District Administration Office at (360) 629-3008, Monday – Friday 9:00am – 5:00pm or by picking one up at 525 East North Camano Drive, Camano Island, WA 98282.

Part Time Firefighter members can be scheduled for up to 36 hours per week earning \$9.73 per hour and are eligible for overtime beyond that threshold. Members are enrolled in the state PERS retirement plan and are also included in the agency's AD&D and Group Life Insurance Plans. Pay periods are scheduled monthly.
