- Agency Alignment Dave Kraski will bring proposal forward next month.
- Nurse Navigator see attachment further discussion followed; unable to find ways to have agencies opt out at this time. Dispatch steering committee recommends moving forward with the program. FD22, 19, 24, 15, 21, 17, sky valley, fd5, not in favor of it at this time. Ask is to continue to fund the system through 2025. Cost is @\$400,000, half is covered by grants, we are currently on a month to month system. Goal of nurse nav line was to help people get to the care that solves their problem. Captain Picknell would like to have this program attached to the CARES program for those that would be able. There is currently not a connection point, but other agencies have been able to integrate the crps. Round table discussion requests for a pause button for more research to be done. Joe to select a date and request reps from each agency to investigate this earlier. Majority consensus will be to pause this program.
- ODA update Dave Kraski chief Crandall taking the unofficial lead on this, moving forward with investigating further, it will come down to agency CBA, hope to have a presentation at a future meeting.
- Radio Replacement Project Update Terry Peterson see attachment. Training video sent out today. Will be on Target Solutions shortly. Also available on Sno911 site. Andrews would like to see a plan that each radio has vhf available again in the future. Motion by Chief Andrews sometime in the future to have a plan to have vhf available in the future and make it a priority. Chief Waller seconded. Discussion followed. Terry advised that deep discussions about what the problem is and how to solve it is the best. He hears and understands what is being asked. Motion carries.

- -Received phone contact from a Fire Commissioner with Fire District 27 (Hat Island) acting as the Fire Chief questioning the assessments. Discussed the SOPB and the ILA between agencies. He asked for some further contact when the Fire Chief returns.
- -UASI grant support for Structure Collapse training in Seattle first 2 weeks of June. Sending 8 members.
- -Scheduled Snohomish County Technical Rescue Academy in April and May.
- -Team training for HazMat and Tech Rescue underway. Training verification forms being completed now for 2024 and will be presented to the SOPB for review in April.
- -2026 budget planning beginning in April for SOPB Adoption before June 1, 2025.
- -Working with SOPB on upstaffing a Technical Rescue Unit for expected weather events. Unit will be staffed by participating agencies and capable of support for all agencies.
 - -Concept phase now, exploring labor issues and staffing guidelines. Further information coming.
