- -2025 Assessments were mailed out early February to all agencies.
- -Received phone contact from a Fire Commissioner with Fire District 27 (Hat Island) acting as the Fire Chief questioning the assessments. Discussed the SOPB and the ILA between agencies. He asked for some further contact when the Fire Chief returns.
- -UASI grant support for Structure Collapse training in Seattle first 2 weeks of June. Sending 8 members.
- -Scheduled Snohomish County Technical Rescue Academy in April and May.
- -Team training for HazMat and Tech Rescue underway. Training verification forms being completed now for 2024 and will be presented to the SOPB for review in April.
- -2026 budget planning beginning in April for SOPB Adoption before June 1, 2025.
- -Working with SOPB on upstaffing a Technical Rescue Unit for expected weather events. Unit will be staffed by participating agencies and capable of support for all agencies.
- -Concept phase now, exploring labor issues and staffing guidelines. Further information coming.
